### **Obituary**

Glenna Louise (Miller) Frigon, 86, beloved wife of the late Gerard T. Frigon (1988), died peacefully on (September 19, 2013), surrounded by her loving family in her home in Coventry. She was born on July 27, 1927 in Coventry, daughter of the late Glenna (Woodruff) and Fred Miller. Glenna graduated from Manchester High School in 1946 and Hartford Hospital School of Nursing in 1949. She met her husband, Gerard "Jerry" Frigon in 1949 and they were married in 1950. Glenna worked as a registered nurse at Hartford Hospital for many years, and also at Kimberly Hall in Windsor as a private duty nurse. In addition to her work as a nurse, Glenna and her husband started G & F Mechanical Contractors in 1965, a heating and air conditioning business in Bloomfield. Over the years the heating and air conditioning business became Connecticut Solar and later was renamed Pro-Mech. Glenna worked with her husband and sons at Pro-Mech and helped to manage the business until she was in her late 70's. Glenna cherished her family and was so proud of each and every one of them. She loved to cook and always enjoyed having everyone to her house to celebrate birthdays and holidays and having the whole gang to her house routinely for Sunday dinners. She was a warm, compassionate, kind, and caring woman. Glenna loved gardening and flower arranging. She would create the most beautiful gardens around her home and bring lovely arrangements to any celebration. She also raised cockatiels that brought her much joy over the years. Glenna lived in Bloomfield most of her adult life until she moved back to Coventry in December of 1995. She moved into a home built by her sons on the property owned by Glenna's parents before they died. Glenna was a member of the Sacred Heart Church in Bloomfield, and returned to Bloomfield for Mass routinely even after moving to Coventry. Glenna was also a long time member of the Town and Country Garden Club of Bloomfield. She was an avid UCONN Women's Basketball fan, and attended many games at the University or watched games on TV with friends and family. Glenna leaves behind three daughters and two sons and their spouses and significant others, Linda Frigon and her husband Joseph Kulowiec of Old Saybrook, Diane Frigon of Port St. Lucie, FL, Jean Frigon and John Kunz of Coventry, Paul and Kimberly Frigon of West Hartford, and Gerard "Ted" and Suzanne Frigon of Simsbury; seven grandchildren, Dawn Paquette, Dayl and Dennis Badenhop Jr., Jessica and Samantha Frigon, and Gerard and Nicholas Frigon; five great grandchildren, Alexis, Bryanna, Dustin and Evan Paquette, and Christian Badenhop; two sisters and their husbands Joan and Robert Thorp of Charlton, MA
