It seems that Georges Henri wanted to be well established before starting a family. At the age of 19, he was found in Newport, Vermont, and the following year in 1915 in Boston, Massachusetts. He applied for naturalization at age 21 in Rhode Island and took his pledge of allegiance three years later, when he was 24.

At the end of spring 1921, Georges Henri Frigon, merchant, returned to Sainte-Geneviève-de-Batiscan, the time to get married. He is 26 years old and Marguerite Marie 24 years old. They will settle in the United States, in Central Falls, in Rhode Island, where Georges Henri exercises the profession of merchant.

According to the 1940 census, they live at 60 Eben Brown's Lane, Central Falls City, Providence County, RI and he is still a self-employed merchant.
