In Halibut Channel; lighthouse on east end.

LOW ISLAND

Situated at entrance to Forward Inlet.

MALAHAT

A land district comprising the southern portion of the E. & N. Ry. land grant. It extends from Goldstream north to Shawnigan Lake.

MALCOLM ISLAND

A Government reservation in the Queen Charlotte Sound, about 5 miles northwest of Johnstone Strait.

QUATSINO

A post office and settlement on the north side of Quatsino Sound, 15 miles east of Winter Harbor. The inhabitants are chiefly Norwegians, being part of a colony formed by the late Colonel Baker. Has post office, wharf, three stores and school and has regular steamship connection with Victoria and other parts of the island, the S.S. "Tees" calling here twice a month. The Quatsino Pulp & Power Company are making preparations for introducing a large pulp mill, they having acquired

a large area at Marble Creek for that purpose. This is a favorite starting point for sportsmen in search of elk, bear, deer and other large game.
