Ned Fregon. Said to be the first settler north of the Seymour Narrows. Said to have been a pioneer Roman Catholic missionary at Village Island, 1845-1846.

Later a free trader at Balaclava Island. Moved to Quatsino about 1890, and pre-empted land. Pronounced "Free-gone". Died about 1918.
